

Junior High Metro Beach Trip

Dear Parents and Guardians,

On **Thursday May 31, 2018**, the 7th and 8th grade classes will be taking a trip to Metro Beach. The cost of the trip will be \$5. Chaperones do not have to pay. We appreciate your help! The busses will be leaving the school at approximately 8:45 A.M and returning before the end of the school day.

Should any student get a discipline referral resulting in OSS or ISS for any length of time between the dates of **May 7** and **May 30**, they will not be able to attend the trip without a parental chaperone. Students that pay in advance and then are not able to go will be given a refund.

Metro Beach offers many activities such as miniature golf, a par 3 golf course, a pool with a water slide, volleyball, tennis, and basketball courts, and space to skateboard or rollerblade. Students planning on golfing or using the pool as well as the snack bar will need to bring extra money. Some of the activities (shuffle board, golf, and tennis) will require students to have their student I.D. in order to borrow equipment. Prices are as follows which are not covered in the entrance fee:

Pool: \$3.00 (plus \$0.50 for the use of a locker) (Bathing suits **MUST** have linings)

Par 3 Golf: \$5.00 – adults, \$4.00 – students (club rental \$0.50/ balls are supplied by the park)

Miniature Golf: \$3.00 (club/ball are supplied by the park) (all fees are approximate)

Additional Things to Remember:

1. All school rules apply.
2. To ensure safety, all students should use the “buddy system”
3. Students who wish to swim should have proper attire both in the pool, as well as when they are not swimming.
4. If students wish to bring their own food (and we suggest they do, due to cost of food at the park and the length of time they spend in line), they must provide their own coolers. No glass containers are allowed. Be aware that coolers **will** be checked.
5. The school will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Whatever the student brings on the trip is his or her responsibility to look after.
