

DJEE Local Purchasing

The board shall purchase school equipment and supplies from local vendors whenever possible, providing that price, quality, and service of the local vendor compare favorably with those from non-local vendors. Bids shall be solicited from non-local vendors in order to establish a fair market price for equipment and supplies.

Local vendors shall be given preference if their bid or quote is within five percent of the low bid or quoted price, not to exceed a maximum of \$100.00, provided that all other matters are equal. Local purchases shall be divided among several local vendors when appropriate. The superintendent shall make all authorized purchases, as he deems best after carefully weighing all matters.
